As a senior physician in hematology and oncology she is one of the governing Directors of the National Center for Tumor

Diseases (NCT), Heidelberg. At NCT she is also the scientific director and spokesperson for EURAT – a research platform for Ethical and Legal Aspects of Translational Medicine at Heidelberg (www.eurat.info).

Eva Winkler is committed to further advance and professionalize medical ethics and shape the discipline and its contribution to research, the healthcare system and politics. Hence, she supports the Academy for Ethics in Medicine (German Society for Ethics in Medicine) as vice president and is elected chairwoman of the Central Ethics Commission at the Federal Medical Association (ZEKO).
